Overview of Haiti's **past** and where this school is located!





Haiti's Past

On the 12 of January 2010 Haiti experienced a 7.0 Earthquake that killed 100,000 to 316,000 and only 8 days later a 6.1 Earthquake. In October of 2010 a Cholera epidemic spread killing 3,597, and sickening 340,000. In 2012, Hurricane Sandy left 200,000 people homeless and devastated the landscape of the country. Lastly in 2021, a magnitude earthquake 7.2 struck Haiti at its epicenter, causing the entire country to fall to an all time low, leaving schools closed, the government to be corrupt and fall, and for the country to be overtaken by gangs.

WHO WE ARE TRYING TO HELP!



Collège Mixte la Modestie is a school in Haiti that has suffered a lot in the past years. Located on the island of Hispaniola in the Caribbean. Our project is focused on the College Mixte La Modestie, a small rural school situated north-west of Port-au-Prince, in Cabaret. In 2021, one of the largest earthquakes ever to hit Haiti left behind significant amounts of damage. The school was shut down for about six months due to the earthquake and now needs our help. Children haven't been able to receive an education at school and are currently behind in education. They now need **your** help more than ever to start school again.





WHY THEY NEED OUR HELP!

If you're asking why you should help them, here are a few reasons. First, they don't have the materials you picture our schools having. Just something as simple as pencils and erasers is something that they might not own. To the students that study there, *nearly anything helps*. They don't even have access to backpacks, nor do they have electricity. The schools need this help as they require funding to function. They're left to fend for themselves as their government has completely failed.

We've been working with the school as a non-profit organization for the past four years. We've been in contact with the school and constantly sending over aid to their students. Besides money, we also have sent packages of pencils, erasers, pens, notebooks, folders, backpacks and money for food.

The students of the school we're working with need about **1600 dollars** for their problems due to the natural disasters that have occurred within the past few years. This includes food insecurity and a lack of school supplies. Their country is riddled with gang violence, hogging life's necessities.
