Haïti's Education

Availability:

There are around 3,000,000 people that live in Haïti, and about 57% of children enroll in primary school. About 30% of these students will stay in education until 6th grade.



Due to a long history of political unrest, natural disasters, and financial debt, many Haïtian children don't have the opportunity to go to school. Haïti is on a Caribbean island called Hispaniola. In 1804 they became the first nation-state to have a successful slave revolt. This victory started a chain of events that ended the Atlantic Slave Trade.

Who are we helping?

We are donating to 110 students at Le Collège Mixte La Modestie. Le Collège Mixte La Modestie is a school in Cabaret, near Haïti's capital.
